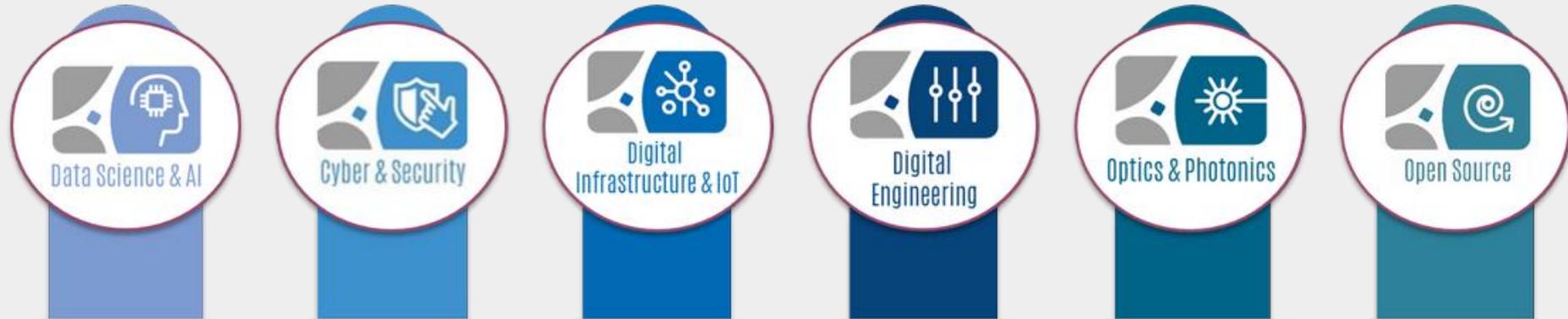

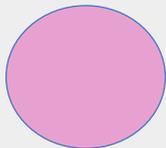

A co-construction between the Territories' Steering Committee and the associated territories



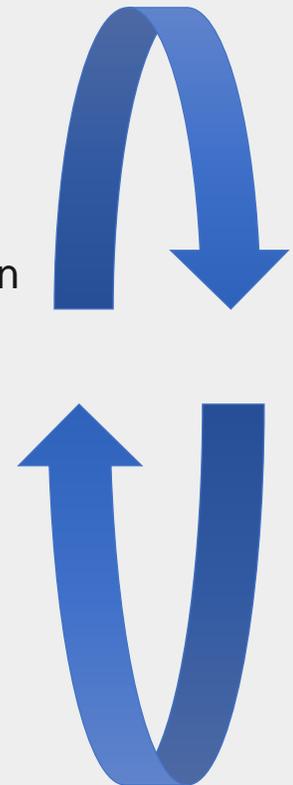
- Territorial data platform for mobility (later declination for energy)

Governance



- ✓ The president along with its VPs represent Systematic and the Territories group
- ✓ Defines the roadmap, priorities, work plan and actions
- ✓ Meets monthly to ensure progress on topics covered by working groups

- ✓ **Territories form a college that meets for major decisions with the Steering Committee (3 to 4 times a year)**
