2017 Achievements: ETIP SNET Implementation Plan 2017-2020


A new structure reflecting the cross-cutting nature of market and digital aspects and the integration of the energy system, with 39 topics





2017 Achievements: ETIP SNET Implementation Plan 2017-2020

A successful public consultation with contributions received from 69 organisations: 530 comments addressed which resulted in some amendments in the IP





2017 Achievements

ETIP SNET Regional Workshops

- Aachen (18-19 September): 14 projects presented, 82 participants
- Lisbon (28-29 September): 17 projects presented, 130 participants
- Cyprus (23-24 November co-organized with JRC): 15 projects presented, 100 participants
- Riga (7-8 December): 13 projects presented, 55 participants
- → Valuable recommendations formulated for future R&I activities to be specified in the next roadmap


