








Prioritising research in Energy crucial for achieving the Paris **Agreement Targets**

ETIP SNET Position on Missions for Horizon Europe

Current EU proposed Missions for Horizon Europe do not include Energy. This omission creates a risk of not prioritising future research needed to meet the Paris agreement targets. We are asking the members of the Council and the European Parliament to include Energy and Decarbonisation among the themes of the first missions that will be adopted at the end 2018-early 2019.

A number of missions will be included in Horizon Europe, the next framework programme (2021-2027) and these will specifically target global challenges. The targets would be clearly measurable and need to be achievable with a portfolio of research and innovation measures1

Of the total amount proposed for the future Horizon Europe Framework Programme (2021-2027), 9.4 billion Euro (10%) will be allocated to the 4-5 missions finally selected. The decision on themes for missions belongs to the Council and the European Parliament.

On 15th October the European Commission proposed 12 broad themes for missions2, which were narrowed down to 4 or 5 by Member States on 17 October3, these are in the fields of

- Digitisation.
- Health,
- "Clean Europe"
- Food and agriculture.

ETIP SNET proposes a broad, goal-oriented Mission: Decarbonising Europe by 2050.

On 2nd October the members of the ETIP SNET (The European Technology and Innovation Platform for Smart Networks for Energy Transition), in line with the Paris agreement, proposed their mission orientated goal for Europe:
